In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act expanding democratic participation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 51 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following 2
- 2 paragraphs:-
- 3 Every citizen who (i) is 16 or 17 years old, (ii) is not temporarily or permanently
- 4 disqualified by law because of corrupt practices in respect to elections, (iii) is a resident in the
- 5 city or town where they claim the right to vote at the time they register and (iv) has complied
- 6 with the requirements of this chapter may have their name entered on the list of voters in such
- 7 city or town and may vote therein in any municipal election.
- 8 Every citizen who (i) is 16 or 17 years old, (ii) is not temporarily or permanently
- 9 disqualified by law because of corrupt practices in respect to elections, (iii) is a resident in the
- 10 city or town where they claim the right to vote at the time they register and (iv) has complied
- with the requirements of this chapter may have their name entered on the list of voters in such

- 12 city or town and may vote therein in any presidential primary; provided, that, the political party
- for which a presidential primary is held shall consent to the participation of 16 and 17 year old
- voters.
