### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to expedited referrals by legislators.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

2 Section 219. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a state agency

3 shall disclose to a state legislator or an authorized staff person of a state legislator, who is

4 reaching out to the agency on behalf of a constituent, personal information about the constituent

5 to the extent necessary for the state legislator or authorized staff person to provide assistance on

6 the behalf of the constituent; provided, however, that the state agency shall not require an

7 authorization for release of information from the constituent or state legislator unless otherwise

8 required by federal law.
