**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to voter registration.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 42G1/2 of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
2 official edition, is hereby amended by striking out the following in subsection (d):

3 If necessary to comply with federal law, the division of medical assistance and the
4 commonwealth health insurance connector authority may allow an applicant to decline to register
5 to vote at the time of application. Otherwise, all automatic voter registration agencies, including
6 the registry of motor vehicles, shall transmit records of all eligible applicants as provided in
7 subsection (e) and these applicants may decline to register to vote only after receiving notice
8 from the registrars under paragraph (3) of said subsection (d) of said section 65.
