## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act further protecting tenants.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 8A of Chapter 239 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting before the first paragraph the following:-
- 3 Section 8A(a). As used in this section and in Chapter 239, the following words shall,
- 4 unless the context clearly requires otherwise, have the following meanings:
- 5 "Tenant," a person who holds possession of a premises in exchange for consideration
- 6 given to an owner;
- 7 "Subtenant," a person who holds possession of a premises in exchange for consideration
- 8 given to a Tenant or other Subtenant;

- 10 "Consideration," money or services whether pursuant to a written or verbal agreement or
- 11 domestic relationship.
