In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to deeds excise receipts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 64D of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 Section 1 the following section:-
- 3 Section 1A. (a) Notwithstanding any other general or special law to the contrary, the
- 4 counties of Bristol, Dukes, Nantucket, Norfolk and Plymouth shall retain 20 per cent of all deeds
- 5 excise receipts received on or after July 1, 2025, in addition to the amounts of deeds excise
- 6 receipts retained by said counties pursuant to any other statute or regulation. Such funds shall be
- deposited to the General Fund of the county, and shall be disbursed and expended for meeting
- 8 the costs of the operation and maintenance of the county, or retained by the county for such
- 9 future use.
- 10 (b) Notwithstanding any other general or special law to the contrary, the county of
- Barnstable shall retain 7.5 per cent of all deeds excise receipts received pursuant to this chapter

- on or after July 1, 2025, in addition to the amounts of deeds excise receipts retained by said
- county pursuant to any other statute or regulation. Such funds shall be deposited to the General
- 14 Fund of the county, and shall be disbursed and expended for meeting the costs of the operation
- and maintenance of the county, or retained by the county for such future use.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
