## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act ensuring the timely release of a vehicle title.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 90D of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting in Section 15 the following subsections:-
- 3 (f) Any lienholder in possession of a motor vehicle title shall provide the title to the
- 4 purchaser or lessee of the vehicle within 7 days of full payment of the vehicle's purchase price,
- 5 lease buyout, or financing agreement.
- 6 (g) Failure to comply with this requirement shall result in a penalty of \$500 per day of
- 7 non-compliance, to be assessed by the Registry of Motor Vehicles.
- 8 (h) The Registry of Motor Vehicles shall promulgate regulations to ensure compliance
- 9 with this section.
