By Representative Garballey of Arlington, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3102) of Sean Garballey and Paul J. Donato relative to the senior property tax exemption. Revenue.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)

An Act expanding the senior property tax exemption.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 59, Section 5, subsection 41C is hereby amended by striking out the words:

2 “A city, by vote of its council and approval of its mayor, or a town, by vote of town
3 meeting, may adjust the following factors contained in these provisions by: 1) reducing the
4 requisite age of eligibility to any person age 65 years or older; 2) increasing either or both of the
5 amounts contained in the first sentence of this clause, by not more than 100 per cent;” and
6 replacing with the following new text:

7 “A city, by vote of its council and approval of its mayor, or a town, by vote of town
8 meeting, may adjust the following factors contained in these provisions by: 1) reducing the
9 requisite age of eligibility to any person age 65 years or older; 2) increasing either or both of the
10 amounts contained in the first sentence of this clause, by not more than 100 per cent, or
11 increasing the \$500 exemption in the first sentence up to \$2,000;”
