Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
  amended by inserting after the definition of "Candidate's committee" the following definition:
- "Adult-care services," care services provided to a candidate's parent or other adult
  dependent, including, but not limited to, caregiving services by an individual, non-profit or forprofit organization that provides such services, and any other costs directly related to such
  services that occur as a result of campaign activities; provided, however, that expenses related to
  adult-care services shall not include payments to a family member, as defined in section 1 of
  chapter 50, of the individual receiving care, unless the family member owns, operates, or is
  employed by a professional caregiving service, and the cost of the service is not greater than the
- SECTION 2. Section 6 of said chapter 55, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting, after the word "office," in line 66, the following:

- or expenses relating to the provision of adult-care services that would not otherwise exist
- but for the existence of the campaign.
- SECTION 3. The director of campaign and political finance shall promulgate regulations
