In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to loaning personal property.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Section 32 of Chapter 135 of the Acts of 2024, is hereby amended by
2	striking subsection 121B(b) in its entirety, and putting in place thereof:
3	(b) All firearm transactions within the commonwealth, including, but not limited to, all
4	purchases, sales, rentals, leases, or other transfers shall be reported to the electronic firearms
5	registration system. All firearm transactions shall be reported by all parties to the transaction via

6 the electronic firearms registration system within 7 days of the sale, rental, lease, or other

7 transfer; provided, however, that no report shall be required for a loan of a firearm to a duly

8 licensed or exempted person for a period of less than 1 year.
