## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to the right to wear personal protective medical equipment.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. The following, as used in this chapter, unless the text otherwise requires or
2	a different meaning is specifically required, shall mean—
3	'Protective medical equipment,' equipment that is worn to minimize exposure to health
4	risks, which includes, but is not limited to, face masks, respirators, gloves, face shields,
5	protective eyewear, and gowns.
6	SECTION 2. (a) No individual shall be discriminated against or penalized for wearing
7	necessary personal protective medical equipment.
8	(b) Discrimination includes, but is not limited to, denial of service, eviction from
9	premises, termination of employment or undue pressure to refrain from wearing personal
10	protective medical equipment.

- 11 SECTION 3. The request to momentarily remove personal protective medical equipment
- 12 is acceptable at security checkpoints and at the request of law enforcement for identification
- 13 purposes.
