In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act regulating drones.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting, after section 39G, the following:-
- 3 Section 39H. For the purposes of this section, the following words shall have the
- 4 following meanings, unless the context clearly requires otherwise:
- 5 "Unmanned Aerial Vehicle", "UAV", or "drone" shall mean a powered aerial vehicle
- 6 that: (i) does not carry a human operator and is operated without the possibility of direct human
- 7 intervention from within or on the aircraft; (ii) uses aerodynamic forces to provide vehicle lift;
- 8 (iii) can fly autonomously or be piloted remotely; (iv) can be expendable or recoverable; and (v.)
- 9 weighs less than 55lbs.
- 10 "Chinese state-owned company" shall mean any corporation, business, association,
- partnership, venture, limited liability company, or other entity or business association owned
- fully or in part by, or affiliated with, the government of China.

- 13 Section 39I. Acquisition of unmanned aerial vehicles
- 14 Chinese state-owned companies shall not be authorized to sell or distribute unmanned
- aerial vehicles or drones in the Commonwealth.
