An Act relative to drivers education.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 32G of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after line 239 the following sentence:-

3           The registrar may approve a driver education curriculum presented in a virtual instructor-  
4 led format by a state-licensed driving school if the following conditions are met: —(a) the  
5 driving school owns or leases physical offices and/or classrooms in the Commonwealth to  
6 provide in-person instruction (b) the driving school has no less than three consecutive years of  
7 operation in the Commonwealth (c) the driving school is in good standing with the Registry of  
8 Motor Vehicles.
