## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to drivers education.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 32G of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after line 239 the following sentence:-
- 3 The registrar may approve a driver education curriculum presented in a virtual instructor-
- 4 led format by a state-licensed driving school if the following conditions are met: —(a) the
- 5 driving school owns or leases physical offices and/or classrooms in the Commonwealth to
- 6 provide in-person instruction (b) the driving school has no less than three consecutive years of
- 7 operation in the Commonwealth (c) the driving school is in good standing with the Registry of
- 8 Motor Vehicles.
