In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to public safety personnel.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 91 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (e) the following subsections:-

3 (f) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraphs (a) to (d), inclusive, any individual who 4 retires from Group IV, who had been employed as either a municipal police officer or firefighter, 5 of any rank, may provide consulting services to one or more municipalities, either individually as 6 a sole proprietor or retained by a corporation or other business entity, for such period of time and 7 for such mutually agreed upon compensation as the municipality deems necessary and 8 appropriate provided such contractual relationship does not involve a conflict of interest in 9 violation of Chapter 268A of the General Laws. 10 (g) The restrictions against post-retirement earnings contained in this section shall not

11 apply to a retired member of Group IV that subsequently is selected to serve as either the

- 12 Secretary of Public Safety and Security, the Undersecretary of Public Safety and Security, or is
- 13 employed in any capacity for the Municipal Police Training Committee or the Department of
- 14 Fire Services Academy.
