## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act incentivizing inclusionary zoning.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 40A, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- 3 (5) An inclusionary zoning ordinance or by-law that requires not more than 13 per cent of
- 4 units be affordable; provided, however, that such zoning ordinance or by-law shall not unduly
- 5 constrain the production of housing in the area impacted by the inclusionary zoning ordinance or
- 6 by-law; provided further, that such ordinance or by-law shall require a density bonus; and
- 7 provided further, that the executive office of housing and livable communities may issue
- 8 guidelines or promulgate regulations consistent with this paragraph.
