An Act relative to veteran disability benefits.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 6B of chapter 115 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 19, 28 and 35, the figure “\$2,000”,  
3 each time it appears, and inserting in place thereof, in each instance, the following figure:-  
4 \$5,000.

5 SECTION 2. Said section 6B of said chapter 115, as so appearing, is hereby further  
6 amended by inserting after the third paragraph the following paragraph:-

7 A veteran who suffers from post-traumatic stress disorder, symptoms of Persian Gulf  
8 illness, or injuries connected to tainted, poisoned or adulterated water at Camp Lejeune and such  
9 disorder, illness, or injuries have been certified by the Veterans’ Administration as service-  
10 connected and who is determined to be 80 per cent disabled by the Veterans’ Administration

- 11 shall be paid the sum of \$5,000 annually in 2 equal payments on August 1 and February 1. Such
- 12 payments shall be due and payable from the date of the application.
