## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to MassHealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 13C of chapter 118E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first paragraph the following
- 3 paragraph:-
- The executive office shall not subject a nursing facility, as defined in 101 CMR 206.02,
- 5 to a downward adjustment of its health care payments based on the failure of the facility to meet
- 6 a specified number of hours per patient per day; provided, however, that nursing homes that have
- 7 a Medicaid utilization rate of 80% or higher, as determined by EOHHS, shall not be subject to
- 8 the downward adjustment of its healthcare payments.
- 9 SECTION 2. The executive office of health and human services shall promulgate or
- amend any regulations necessary to implement this act.
