An Act relative to reasonable municipal expense reimbursement.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Section 69H of Chapter 164 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the  
3 following clause:--

4           “(5) the board shall consider the requests of municipalities for reimbursement of expenses  
5 spent in relation to the application and shall assess fees on applicants for reasonable municipal  
6 expenses related to the application.”
