In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act to increase safety on public ways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1: General Laws Part I Title XVI Chapter 111E, is amended to include the
- 2 following Section 9B which provides:
- 3 (a) For the purposes of this section, "incapacitated" shall have the same meaning as 4 is defined in Section 9A of Chapter 111E.
- 5 (b) Where an incapacitated person is found to be the operator of or in possession of a
- 6 motor vehicle on a public way, that motor vehicle shall be towed away and impounded for a
- 7 period of twelve (12) hours.
- 8 (c) This (12) hour impoundment period shall be calculated from the time the vehicle
- 9 is towed. The costs for the towing, storage and maintenance of the vehicle shall be borne by the

- operator or individual who retrieves the vehicle after the twelve (12) hour hold period is
- 11 complete.
