An Act relative to school absences.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 76 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "week." in line 30, the following
- 3 words:-
- 4 Absences may also be permitted for students participating in national or international
- 5 competition sanctioned by a U.S. national governing body as defined in 36 Unities States Code
- 6 2205, referred to as the Ted Stevens Act; provided, however, that students seeking approval shall
- 7 maintain a B grade point average or equivalent in academic courses. The school principal shall
- 8 have discretion over absences excused exceeding seven-day sessions or fourteen half day session
- 9 in a period of six months.
