An Act relative to the fuel tax.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, Section 12 of chapter 64A of the  
2 General Laws, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 "Any sale of fuel for automotive use, including but not limited to unleaded gasoline and  
4 diesel fuel, by a distributor to any public or private entity, or private person in the  
5 commonwealth shall be exempt from the tax per gallon contained in this chapter until such time  
6 as the average price of a gallon of unleaded gasoline, as calculated in the Commonwealth of  
7 Massachusetts by the U.S. Energy Information Administration, is less than one dollar and zero  
8 cents."
