### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act to end child homelessness.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, no family with children under 2 the age of eighteen shall be evicted or removed from public housing, publicly subsidized 3 housing, or a shelter funded in whole or in part with public funds, including a motel or hotel 4 providing emergency shelter, unless and until the Housing Services Unit of the Department of 5 Children and Families, in consultation with the Department of Housing and Community 6 Development, has developed and is able to implement a plan to assure that all children under 7 eighteen in the affected family will be housed in some location which is fit for human habitation. 8 All reasonable efforts shall be made to provide that such children remain in the custody of their 9 parents or other caregivers with whom they have been residing.
