In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act providing for the self-certification of benefits for small businesses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 11 of chapter 175M of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following subsection:-
- 3 (f) An employer with not more than twenty-five employees shall be permitted to submit
- 4 a private plan subject to the requirements of subsection (a)(1) of this section to the department
- 5 directly; provided further, said employer shall be exempt from the requirements set forth in
- 6 subsection (a)(2)(i) and (a)(2)(iii) of this section.
