- Notwithstanding the foregoing, any complaint for simple possession of psilocybin (i.e.,
- 7 not with the intent to distribute), may, in the absence of any indication that the offense caused
- 8 any visible harm to the health and safety of any other person, be dismissed upon a finding by the
- 9 court that at the time of the alleged offense the defendant (1) was over 21 years of age, (2) was
- 10 not operating a motor vehicle, and (3) endangered no children.
