5	SECTION 2. Said section 6B of said chapter 159B, as so appearing, is hereby amended
6	by inserting the following after the word "way", in line 17, the following words:- or pursuant to
7	removal from a private way or property.
8	SECTION 3. Section 39A of chapter 255 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
9	amended by striking out the words "removed from the scene of an accident", in lines 1 and 2,
10	and inserting in place thereof the following words:- involuntarily towed or transported pursuant
11	to section 6B of chapter 159B.
