Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "property", in line 904, the
- 3 following words:- "or after having reason to know that he collided with or otherwise caused
- 4 injury to any other vehicle or property,".
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 24 of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
- 6 inserting after the words "death of any person", in line 954, the following words:- "or after
- 7 having reason to know that he collided with or otherwise caused injury to any person not
- 8 resulting in the death of any person,".
- 9 SECTION 3. Section 24 of chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
- striking out the word "shall", in line 964, and inserting in place thereof the following words:- "or

- after having reason to know that he collided with or otherwise caused injury to any person,
- 12 shall,".
