An Act to protect the collective bargaining rights of certain administrative employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The definition of “Employee” in section 1 of chapter 150E of the General Laws, as  
2    appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second sentence  
3    the following sentence:- No person employed by the commonwealth in the Management  
4    Classification Series below the level of M-VI shall be excluded from the coverage of this chapter  
5    unless either the department of labor relations has determined that the actual duties of the  
6    particular position or positions meet the test of a managerial employee established in this  
7    definition or an agreement exists with the exclusive representative of the bargaining unit that  
8    covers similar types of work.
