In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to teaching certification.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 38G of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 154
- of the acts of 2022, is hereby further amended by inserting after the fifteenth paragraph the
- 3 following paragraph:-
- For a person who, because of a temporary or permanent disability arising from
- 5 intellectual, sensory, emotional, physical or environmental factors, or other specific learning
- 6 disabilities, is or would be unable to pass the written examination, the board shall create a
- 7 practical alternative assessment to the test requirement of the eligibility criteria for certification
- 8 as a provisional educator and certification as a provisional educator with advanced standing.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect 180 days following its passage.
