This is a submission of our thirty-eighth request for expenditure from the County Registers' Technological Fund for the Plymouth County Registry of Deeds, and a request for a referral of this plan to the Committees on Ways and Means and Post Audit and Oversight. I respectfully request that this submission be entered into your docket at your earliest convenience.

Consistent with the provisions of Section 4 of Chapter 4 of the Acts of 2003 and M.G.L. Chapter 29, §2KKK, the proposed expenditures are for purposes of technological improvements at the Plymouth County Registry of Deeds utilizing systems interoperable with other like systems used by other registries. In preparing this plan, I have consulted with the Commonwealth's Chief Information Officer and the State Secretary in accordance with the approval process. Their responses are attached.

The specific proposed expenditures totaling Nine Hundred Twenty-eight Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$928,490.00) are identified in the attached copy

of our thirty-eighth request. We also have included an update, as of December 9, 2024, of the funds available within our account.
