In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to fees for student organizations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 47 of Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 adding the following sentence:-
- No participant shall be required to pay a fee to participate in any school organization or
- 4 student activity whose primary purpose is: (i) political; (ii) faith-based; (iii) charitable; (iv)
- 5 promoting positive mental or physical health, or raising awareness of the importance thereof; (v)
- 6 student leadership activities included but not limited to student council or being a class officer;
- 7 (vi) opposing, preventing, addressing, or raising awareness of discrimination or racism, sexism,
- 8 and other forms of bigotry; (vii) opposing, preventing, addressing, or raising awareness of
- 9 bullying; or (viii) any other purpose deemed by the committee to be a social good.
