An Act relative to fraternal organizations conducting bazaars.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 7A of chapter 271 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by striking out the last paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following  
3 paragraph:-

4           No organization issued a permit under this section shall conduct more than 1 bazaar in  
5 any single calendar day. The operation of a bazaar shall be limited to 5 consecutive hours.
