An Act exempting precious metal purchases from state sales tax.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Clause (II) of section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 2022 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the clause and inserting in place  
3 thereof the following:-

4           "(II) Sales of (i) rare coins of numismatic value; (ii) gold or silver bullion or coins; or (iii)  
5 gold or silver tender of any nation traded and sold according to its value as precious metal. The  
6 word "bullion" shall not include fabricated precious metal which has been processed or  
7 manufactured for industrial, professional or artistic uses."
