Brownsberger (by vote of the town) that the town of Belmont be authorized to further regulate the application of second-generation anticoagulant rodenticides in said town. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court

An Act authorizing the town of Belmont to prohibit or restrict the application of second-generation anticoagulant rodenticides.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Town of
2 Belmont is hereby authorized to enact and enforce local regulations, bylaws, or ordinances
3 prohibiting or restricting the use of second-generation anticoagulant rodenticides within the
4 boundaries of the Town, including but not limited to their use on public and private properties.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
