An Act relative to a cemetery in the town of Norton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The treasurer of the Town of Norton may pay from sums appropriated
2 unpaid bills incurred by the town in the amount of \$34,001.00 to Ryan Asphalt Paving, LLC, for
3 the work performed in connection with the driveway pavement projects at the Timothy Plains
4 Cemetery notwithstanding the failure of the town to comply with the laws relative to
5 procurement and competitive bidding in the awarding of the contracts for completion of the
6 work.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
