An Act regulating elections in the town of Conway.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 53 of the general laws, or any other general or  
2 special law or by-law of the town of Conway to the contrary, the caucuses for the nomination of  
3 town officers shall be eliminated in the town of Conway, and the nomination of eligible  
4 candidates for town offices shall be made by the filing of nomination papers in accordance with  
5 sections 7 and 10 of chapter 35 of the general laws. Ballots used at a regular or special town  
6 election of town officers shall not have printed thereon a party or political designation or mark,  
7 and there shall not be any political designation or mark appended to the name of a candidate for  
8 town office.

9           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
