SUBJECT: November 2025 UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE TRUST FUND INFORMATION

The following information relates to the reporting on the Unemployment Insurance Trust Fund ("UI Trust Fund") for the month of October 2025.

As of October 31, 2025, the preliminary Massachusetts UI Trust Fund ending balance was \$1.90 billion.

Year-to-date through October 31, 2025, preliminary employer contributions totaled \$1.44 billion.

Year-to-date through October 31, 2025, DUA paid \$1.96 billion in benefits for regular UI for 690,802 initial and continuing claims.

This update contains information related only to actual dollars collected or disbursed. On January 17, 2025, the Commonwealth and the U.S. Department of Labor entered into an agreement that fully resolved any outstanding liability related to pandemic unemployment insurance overdraws as a result of federal UI programs established during the COVID-19 pandemic. The impact of this agreement is reflected in the October 2025 projections contained in the Unemployment Insurance Trust Fund Annual Outlook



Report. The Commonwealth's first payment under the agreement is due December 1, 2025.
