## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act to provide to certain employees of the Commonwealth the right to participate collectively in the political process.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 13 of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end of the first sentence of the first
- 3 paragraph the following: "...nor shall it prohibit the solicitation of contributions by such
- 4 employee from fellow employees for a political committee organized by the exclusive
- 5 representative of such employee under chapter 150E of the general laws where the purpose of
- 6 such committee is the improvement of terms and conditions of employment of such employees."
