### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to the town of Plymouth Harbormaster employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Section 1: In the town of Plymouth, the position of Harbormaster, and the town of

- 2 Plymouth Harbormaster Department employees who have statutory powers of law enforcement,
- 3 shall be Group 4 employees pursuant to M.G.L. c. 32, § 3(2)(g). Notwithstanding any provision
- 4 in M.G.L. c. 32, §§ 1-28, inclusive to the contrary, all prior creditable service rendered before the
- 5 effective date of this act rendered by the Harbormaster and Harbormaster Department employees
- 6 as of the date of this act will be considered Group 4 service.
- 7 Section 2: This act shall take effect upon its passage.
