An Act relative to the town of Plymouth Harbormaster employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           In the town of Plymouth, the position of Harbormaster, and the town of Plymouth  
2 Harbormaster Department employees who have statutory powers of law enforcement, shall be  
3 Group 4 employees pursuant to M.G.L. c. 32, § 3(2)(g). Notwithstanding any provision in  
4 M.G.L. c. 32, §§ 1-28, inclusive to the contrary, all prior creditable service rendered before the  
5 effective date of this act rendered by the Harbormaster and Harbormaster Department employees  
6 as of the date of this act will be considered Group 4 service.

7           Section 2: This act shall take effect upon its passage.
