An Act relative to probation officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 58 of chapter 30 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 20, after the word “or,” the following  
3 words:- in the case of a probation officer, receives bodily injuries resulting from acts of violence  
4 perpetrated on them while in the performance of their duties or,
