**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act amending Bridgewater town charter article II, legislative branch, term limits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 ORDERED, that the Town Council assembled votes to amend the Bridgewater Home
2 Rule Charter, Article II, Section 2-12 and to send said amendment to the State Legislature as a
3 Special Act as follows:

4 Section 2-12(b) shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

5 (b) Term Limits –

6 (1) No person shall be eligible to be elected or appointed as a District Council member of
7 the Town Council if, at any point during the term of office for which the person may be elected
8 or appointed, the service of the eligible person would exceed four District Councilor elections
9 terms or appointments to the Town Council.

10 (2) No person shall be eligible to be elected or appointed as an At-large Council member
11 of the Town Council if, at any point during the term of office for which the person may be

12 elected or appointed, the service of the eligible person would exceed four elections terms or
13 appointments to the Town Council.

14 (3) For the purpose of this section, prior service as an At-Large Councilor shall not
15 prevent seeking election as a District Councilor. Prior service as a District Councilor shall not
16 prevent seeking election as an At-Large Councilor.

17 (4) A term lasting less than 24 months shall not be included in calculating the total
18 number of terms served by a member of the Town Council.

19 years after such removal by recall or resignation.”

20 This act shall take effect upon approval by a majority of the voters of the city known as
21 the town of Bridgewater but not otherwise.
