**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court  
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to extending the police chief's service to the town of Leicester.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Notwithstanding Chapter 32, or any general or special law to the contrary,  
2   Kenneth M. Antanavica, Police Chief of the Town of Leicester, may continue to serve in the  
3   position of Police Chief up to April 30, 2028, the last day of the month of his 70th birthday, or  
4   until the date of his retirement, non-reappointment, or the date he is relieved of his duties by the  
5   town, whichever occurs first; provided, however, that he is mentally and physically capable of  
6   performing the duties of his office. No further deductions were made from the regular  
7   compensation of Kenneth M. Antanavica under Chapter 32 of the General Laws for any service  
8   subsequent to April 30, 2025, and upon retirement, he shall receive a superannuation retirement  
9   allowance equal to that which he would have been entitled had he retired on that date.

10           Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
