An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Mark Giampa, an employee of the Massachusetts Department of Correction.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Massachusetts  
2 Department of Correction shall establish a sick leave bank for Mark Giampa, an employee of the  
3 Massachusetts Department of Correction. Any employee of the Massachusetts Department of  
4 Correction may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave  
5 bank for use by Mark Giampa. If Mark Giampa terminates employment with the Massachusetts  
6 Department of Correction or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the  
7 sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall  
8 not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment  
9 of the sick leave bank as determined by the Massachusetts Department of Correction.
