An Act relative to collective bargaining.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 150E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by deleting from the first sentence of the definition of  
3 “employee” the words “...and the officers and employees within the departments of the state  
4 secretary, state treasurer, state auditor and attorney general.”

5           Section 1 of chapter 150E of the General Laws is hereby further amended by adding a  
6 new sentence at the end of the definition of “employer” to read “In the case of employees of the  
7 state secretary, state treasurer, state auditor and attorney general, the employer shall be the state  
8 secretary, state treasurer, state auditor and attorney general respectively.”
