In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to removing the driving restrictions on a car with antique tags.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the definition "Antique motor car" and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the following definition:-
- 4 "Antique motor car", any motor vehicle that is over 25 years old and not used by the
- 5 owner primarily for general transportation purposes. The application for registration shall be
- 6 accompanied by an affidavit upon a form provided by the registrar, which shall include:
- 7 (i) a statement by the owner that the antique motor vehicle is owned and operated solely
- 8 as an antique item and not primarily for general transportation purposes; and
- 9 (ii) registration of another motor vehicle, in the owner's name that is currently used by
- 10 the owner for daily transportation purposes.

- SECTION 2. Section 33 of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- striking out the (13) paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:- For the
- registration of every antique motor car; provided that said fee shall be collected every 2 years.
