**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court  
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to the responsible sale of alcoholic beverages.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 15 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding after the sixth paragraph, the following new  
3 paragraph: --

4 A Section 15 licensee and the Section 15 licensee’s employees shall complete a training  
5 program every three (3) years that includes all of the following: (1) Instruction on the statutes  
6 and rules that govern the off premises sale of beer, wine, ready to drink mixed alcoholic  
7 beverages, and intoxicating liquor in this state; (2) Instruction on preventing the illegal retail of  
8 beer, wine, ready to drink mixed alcoholic beverages, and intoxicating liquor to persons under  
9 twenty-one years of age; (3) Instruction on not selling beer, wine, ready to drink mixed alcoholic  
10 beverages, and intoxicating liquor to intoxicated individuals; and (4) Instruction on preventing  
11 second party sales of beer, wine, ready to drink mixed alcoholic beverages, and intoxicating  
12 liquor that may reasonably result in persons under twenty-one years of age securing alcoholic  
13 beverages.
