Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (d) of section 7 of chapter 150E of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 2022 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words “pursuant to section
3 ninety-seven A of chapter forty-one or” the following words:-

4 “of the colonel of the state police pursuant to chapter 22C of the general laws”.
