**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to PEG access and cable related funds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 53F3/4 of chapter 44 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 7, the word “appropriated” and inserting in
3 place thereof the following words:-
4 expended by the board, commission, committee, head of department or officer designated
5 by the issuing authority as defined in section 1 of chapter 166A, without further appropriation.
