**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act prohibiting the use of lead paint on outdoor structures.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 196 of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “dwelling”, in line 4, the following
- 3 words:- “or outdoor structure”.
