**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court  
(2025-2026)**

An Act promoting intergovernmental cooperation on criminal enforcement.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 23B of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after Section 30 the  
2 following new section:-

3 Section 30B. Cooperation with Federal Agencies on Criminal Matters.

4 The executive office of housing and livable communities shall cooperate with federal law  
5 enforcement agencies, including the united states citizenship and immigration services and the  
6 united states immigration and customs enforcement, to report and coordinate the immediate  
7 detainment of any nonresident migrant or asylum seeker in the Commonwealth who has been  
8 formally charged with or convicted of a serious crime, including but not limited to rape, murder,  
9 drug trafficking, and felony theft, as defined by state and federal law.
